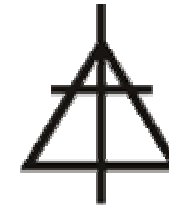
**World Day of Prayer** will be held on Friday, March 5 at 1:30pm at Our Lady of Sorrows Church. Everyone is welcome to attend.
