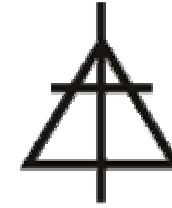

- Council decided to apply to have a Calvin Seminary student do a 10-week internship here this summer.
- The deacons reported that a letter from Aylmer Ministerial's "The Perc" Coffee Shop was received. They are looking for some financial support. A motion to have a second offering in February designated for this cause was approved. A letter explaining the cause will be distributed to the congregation before the offering.
- Jason Postma's request to have his membership transferred to Bethel CRC in Newmarket was approved. Rachel deLange's request to have her Membership Statement transferred to Solomon's Porch Church in Minneapolis, Minnesota and Rev. Rich, Patsy, Erik & Jessica deLange's request to have their memberships transferred to Trinity CRC in Edmonton were approved. We will miss everyone but wish them God's blessings in their new church homes.
- Council received the membership papers of Ryan, Annette & Shane Dykxhoorn from Tillsonburg CRC. We welcome them to our church and pray they will soon feel at home among us.
