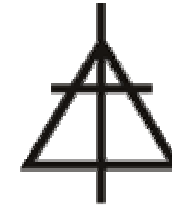
**The Banner:** The latest issue of *The Banner* has arrived. You may pick up a copy at the back of the church or on the table outside of the overflow.
