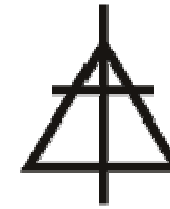

Senior Pastor Search Committee Update: Our committee has now met seven times on a monthly schedule. We started off with approximately thirty names of pastors we received from committee members, members of the congregation, and a few responses to the advertisement in the Banner. Some of our committee members attended a Saturday at Calvin Seminary that gave opportunity for churches and candidates to introduce each other. The task of reviewing profiles, listening to sermons from websites, and doing some visiting is well underway. Thirty plus names have now been reduced to a handful of persons that the committee members are getting more information on. Through the help of church websites we are able to listen to some sermons from most of them. We are also in the process of scheduling visits with the pastors in some churches where possible. With the summer months here it will be more difficult to get these visits scheduled, because of both the pastors' schedules as well as the committee's. It has been just five months since we have been without a senior pastor. Although we would all like to have a senior pastor again, the committee thanks everyone for their patience in respect of the process. We are all waiting for the Lord's leading and ask for your continued prayer for our committee's work, for our church, and for the pastor who God has already chosen to serve here.
