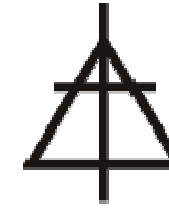

Classis Highlights
Tuesday, September 28, 2010
Essex Christian Reformed Church

- Rev. Fred Heslinga of the host church led delegates in opening devotions.
- 66 delegates from 26 churches were registered for the day. First time delegates all signed the Form of Subscription. Windsor-Ambassador could not attend due to a very serious illness in the pastor's family.
- Classis was declared constituted and Rev. Chris Schievnik of Chatham-Calvary was seated as chairman. Rev. Dr. William Koopmans of Chatham-Grace was seated as vice-chairman.
- Rev. Gerald Hogeterp and his wife Jackie thanked classis for its ongoing support of their ministry in Nigeria. The Hogeterps have now retired and will be taking up residence in Brantford. Ministerial credentials for Rev. Hogeterp will be sent there.
- Diane Plug introduced herself at the new classical representative for Disability Concerns.
- Classis approved in principle the hiring of a Classical Youth Ministry Consultant. The final ratification vote will take place at classis in January 2011.
- The classical budget for 2010-11 was passed. The ministry share per professing member increases from \$50.75 to \$51.00, or 0.49 per cent.
- Beth Fellingner successfully sustained her interview to become a Ministry Associate in Classis Chatham. She is leading the church plant in St. Thomas.
- The next classis meeting will be held on January 25, 2011 D.V. at Wyoming Christian Reformed Church.
